 - Has been accepted at an accredited post-secondary institution.
 - Has a 2.50 or higher cumulative grade point average.
 - Must be a graduating senior from Kenston High School.

 - a. Typed essay (*250 words or less*)
 - b. One letter of recommendation
 - c. High school transcript
